General Tournament Rules

1. All matches will be held in the Granollers Basketball Club pavilion (Girona Street, 222 Granollers), the Can Bassa Municipal Pavilion (Caterina Albert Street, 15 Granollers) and the El Congost Municipal Pavilion (Maria de Palau Street, 19-21, Granollers).
2. Coaches and delegates will be solely responsible for their players.
3. Access to the locker rooms will only be authorized for those teams that have to play their game. After playing it, the teams will have to leave the track, with maximum speed, to comply with the schedule established by the organization.
4. The teams must be accompanied, at all times, by their coach or delegate / day and may only access the locker room 15 minutes before the start of the match.
5. Each team will have, as long as the development of the matches allows, 5 minutes to warm up on the court before starting the match. If the teams want to warm up more time before the game, they can do it to the outdoor courts, never through the halls or inside the pavilion facilities.
6. Access to the locker room and playing area will be restricted to players, coaches, delegates, referees, scorers and members of the organization.
7. All teams will have two different color shirts. In case of coinciding with the opposing team, it will be considered as a visitor in the competition calendar who will change his shirt to avoid confusion.
8. All participating teams must be present on Sunday December 30 at the closing ceremony and awards ceremony of the C.B. Minibàsquet Tournament. Granollers that will take place on Sunday 29 about 18h after the men's and women's finals.

Tournament game rules

I. The matches will have a six-period structure with a one-minute break between each period. Each period will last six minutes each. In the fourth period the basket will be changed.

II. Each team may enter a maximum of twelve players and a minimum of eight in the match minutes. The teams have to present the federative licenses, with the accreditation of the identity, of the players who will participate in the Tournament.

III. Since the duration of the match is less than that of an official match and for the benefit of fair play, the maximum number of personal fouls that a player may commit in a match shall be reduced to four fouls.

IV. In the first five periods all players registered in the minutes must have been aligned from the beginning of a period a minimum of two full periods (except in cases of injury, disqualification or having committed four personal offenses) and a maximum of four periods throughout the game. It is considered that a player has participated in a period when he has intervened, nor is it for a minimum of time.

V. Failure to comply with the previous rule will result in the violation of improper alignment and will result in the loss of the match as long as the offending team has won the match. In this case, the official result of the match will be 2-0.

VI. No substitutions will be granted in the first five periods, except to change an injured / disqualified player who has committed his fourth personal foul; to which it is necessary to substitute whenever players are available to do so, and although the substitution violates the norm that regulates the performance of the players.

VII. If an injured player receives assistance on the court and can continue playing, it does not have to be substituted. In case of being replaced, this period will count as played as complete. You can play again in another period if you recover.

VIII. In the match, that the final result is a draw, in order to break it, an alternative free kick will be taken by each of the five players of each team that were on the court at the end of the match . If the tie persists, one free throw per team will be taken until one of the two teams misses a pitch. The final result of the match will be the one obtained in the sixth period plus the points obtained by each team in the launch of the free throws.

IX. All matches will begin with maximum punctuality, in compliance with the schedule established by the organization.

X. All basket throws that start and end outside the area will be worth three points.

XI The signaling of two unsportsmanlike / technical fouls will be sanctioned with the disqualification of the player or coach. At the age of the players, it will not be necessary to leave the court and the organization will indicate where they should be located. The same criteria will apply to coaches and delegates

XII. In case of a tie between several teams in the group league phase, the following criteria will be followed to undo the tie: if the teams are tied there are two, the points achieved in the matches between them will be taken into account, and it will be the winner The team with the most points. If there are more than two teams tied to points, the classification will be established taking into account, first, the points achieved in the matches played between them. If equality persists, the classification of the teams that continued tied would be made by the difference of score in favor and against in the matches played between them. If the tie still persists, it will be resolved in favor of the team that had obtained the highest favorable score in the course of those matches.

XIII In accordance with the rules of minibasquet of the Catalan Basketball Federation, the timekeeper will stop the match clock only in the following situations:

- a) End of each period,
- b) Dead time,
- c) When a player commits the fifth foul or is penalized with a disqualifying foul,
- d) At the request of the arbitrator
- e) When an infringement of the rules of the game occurs or when the ball goes out of the sideline if a dead time or a substitution was previously requested
- f) Due to penalty penalized with free throw / s.
- g) When a situation withheld ball is sanctioned, and a jump must be administered.

XIV The timekeeper will start the match timer:

- a) In a jump between two, when the ball is first touched by a player,
- b) When a player touches the ball after a throw-in from the baseline or side, if the stopwatch is stopped at the time of service,
- c) After a free throw does not convert, when the ball is touched by a player.

XV. Only one timeout will be available per team during the match, except in the semifinals and in the final two will be available per team. Dead times may be

granted after the referee blows a whistle for any violation of the Rules. (Dead times may not be granted after basket).

XVI. The organization may provide that in the semifinal and final matches, the last period of the game, the rules concerning the arrest and start-up of the timing are made in accordance with the FIBA regulations

XVII In addition to these rules, the tournament will be governed by the official mini basketball regulations of the Catalan Basketball Federation and with the provisions of the FIBA regulations.

XVIII. Participation in the Granollers Basketball Club minibàsquet tournament implies acceptance of these rules and the tournament organizing committee will decide in case of doubt, without prejudice to the submission of the parties to the discipline of the jurisdictional committees of the Catalan Basketball Federation .

COMPETITION STRUCTURE

The tournament consists of 24 teams in the men's category and 10 teams in the women's category. One of the objectives of this tournament is that the participating teams can play the greatest number of matches with teams of similar competitive level. The competition calendar consists of two phases:

- League stage
- Qualifying phase

In the league phase, the 24 men's teams are distributed in 8 groups (A, B, C, D, E, F, G and H) of 3 teams each, playing a league in each group.

The 10 teams in the women's category are distributed in 2 groups (I and J) of five teams each.

In this phase in the men's category each team plays two games, all of them in the first day of competition, on Friday, December 27 and in the women's category, each team plays four games. Two in the day of Friday and the other two in the day of Saturday.

Qualifying Phase

In the men's category, disputed the league phase will be formed by two groups that will be composed of:

- The 16 teams classified in first and second position of their groups that will play the positions 1st to 16th
- The 8 teams classified in third position of their groups and which will be played positions 17 to 24.

In the group where the 1st to 16th positions will be played, they will play the round of 16 with the following order:

- Match 8Q1: 1st team of group A vs 2nd team of group B
- Match 8Q2: 1st team of group B vs 2nd team of group C
- Match 8Q3: 1st team of group C vs 2nd team of group D
- Match 8Q4: 1st team of group D vs 2nd team of group E
- Match 8Q5: 1st team of group E vs 2nd team of group F
- Match 8Q6: 1st team of group F vs 2nd team of group G
- Match 8Q7: 1st team of group G vs 2nd team of group H
- Match 8Q8: 1st team of group H vs 2nd team of group A

The winning teams of the previous matches will play the quarterfinals in the following order:

- Match 4Q1: winner 8Q1 vs winner 8Q2
- Match 4Q2: winner 8Q3 vs winner 8Q4
- Match 4Q3: winner 8Q5 vs winner 8Q6
- Match 4Q4: winner 8Q7 vs winner 8Q8

The winning teams of the previous matches will play the semifinals in the following order:

- Match 2Q1: winner 4Q1 vs winner 4Q2
- Match 2Q2: winner 4Q3 vs winner 4Q4

The final will be played by the winners of these two games.

The same structure will be followed by the losing teams of the aforementioned confrontations to determine the classification of 3rd to 16th classified

In the group where the 17th to 24th positions will be disputed, the following structure will be followed:

- Match Q1: 3rd team of Group A vs 3rd team of Group B
- Match Q2: 3rd team of Group C vs 3rd team of Group D
- Match Q3: 3rd team of Group E vs 3rd team of Group F
- Match Q4: 3rd team of Group G vs 3rd team of Group H

The winning teams of the matches will play for 17th to 20th place and the losers for the 21st to 24th place.

In the women's category, disputed the phase of the league, the semifinals will be played between the crossing of the first classified of group I against the second classified of group J and the first classified of group J against the second classified of group I. The winning teams will play the final and the losers will play 3rd and 4th place.

The third classified of each group will cross against the classified rooms of each group of the league phase. Winning teams will play for 5th and 6th place and losers for 7th and 8th place.

Finally, the fifth classified teams of each group of the league phase will cross to determine the classification of 9th and 10th place.

In addition, in this edition two matches will be played, one in the men's category and one in the women's category of the so-called "All-Star".

In the men's category the White All-Star team will be formed by a player representing each team of groups A, B, C and D and the Blue All-Star team will be formed by a player representing each team from groups E, F, G and H.

In the women's category, the White All-Star team will be formed by two players from each team of group I of the league phase and the All-Star Blue team will be formed by two players from each team of group J of the league phase .

Each team will freely choose their representative in the All-Star and communicate it to the organization before Sunday the 29th. The coaches who will lead the matches will be chosen by the organization.

Next, on the following pages a graphic script of the qualifying phase is included for a better follow-up of the matches specifying dates, schedules and pavilions of the game.
